### REMEMBER TO RAKE YOUR LEAVES



Park Plaza is known for its beautiful trees. While they provide nice shade during the summer, fall isn't for the faint of heart. Remember to rake your leaves and be mindful of city leaf and brush collection dates. One of the benefits of living here is that our HOA dues cover the cost of curbside leaf and brush collection, saving you the hassle of having to haul your leaves to a local drop off site. Also, please don't rake your leaves into the street. That can clog our sewer drains leading to flooding or slower water drainage on our streets.

#### NO LIVE STOCK

This is a friendly reminder that chickens, hens and other livestock that live outdoors are prohibited in Park Plaza.

## REMINDER

- Curbside leaf pickup is on **Monday** of each week
- Each home may put out up to **FIVE** bags each week
- Spring and Fall are the heaviest collection seasons, so your pickup time may vary greatly throughoutthe year
- Place your bags at the curb by 7:00
   a.m. on Mondays to prevent misses
   due to varying collection times.
- DO NOT RAKE LEAVES INTO THE STREET
